Sheila,

Congratulations, Santa Rosa County’s Defense Reinvestment Grant (DRG) proposal has been approved to receive \$60,000 in funding. This award is contingent on the Governor signing into law the FY 15/16 budget, including the \$850,000 appropriation for DRGs.

The next steps are the following (highlighted are items requiring action first):

1. **Send me a quote from that can be included in the Governor’s press release that will officially announce the grant award**
2. **Confirm that who will be signing the grant and that you will be the Agreement Manager listed in the on the contract**
3. Upon receiving the quote, I will send the contract to you
4. The grantees can begin the contract review and approval process
5. Once the Governor signs the budget, I will send an official award letter to grant recipients. At this time, EFI will be able to sign and executes contract
6. EFI will be working with the Governor’s Office to release the press announcements after the budget is signed. Please do not pre-empt the Governor’s office with this news

Note- the sooner I get the quote, the quicker I can send the contract. The sooner I receive the signed contract, the quicker EFI can sign and execute!

There is one significant change that will likely come from the FY 15/16 Legislative Session: while grantees will continue to contract with and report to EFI, payments will come directly from the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) to grantees. There will be no change in your process, but this change will be reflected in the “Payments” section of your contract.

I stand ready to work with you on another success year of DRGs! Thank you for your time and partnership.

*Navarre Beach Fishing Rodeo is growing in popularity and many lodging property managers have said they have bookings generated from this niche event in Santa Rosa County.*

The Navarre Beach Fishing Rodeo has been a successful event that was started in 2013; this will be its third year. The event is scheduled for October 3-4, 2015 and takes place in Navarre and surrounding bodies of water. The projected paid attendance is 144 registered anglers and projected spectators are 800 people for this event. The projected number of out-of-town visitors is between 30-40%. This is a family friendly event and will be featured in Kayak Fishing Magazine in July, 2015.

The TDC Board of Directors voted June 17<sup>th</sup> 2015 with no objections to recommend we spend \$10,000. On this event. This is the same dollar amount of support the TDC has spent on the Navarre Beach Fishing Rodeo the past two event years.

I have looked closely at this event and believe that it is a viable event that will increase bed tax collections, continuing to give our tourists event options to participate in if they so choose while staying with us and believe it will draw day trippers from neighboring counties leaving us with an economic impact dollar value to Santa Rosa County. I as the Tourist Development Director recommend we spend \$10,000. On this year's Navarre Beach Fishing Rodeo and believe it is a growing event that will get larger each year.

The Santa Rosa County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) made the following determinations at their meeting held on December 13, 2012, for the property located at 1170 Circle Lane, Gulf Breeze, Florida, and identified as parcel numbers 31-25-28-0000-02900-0000 & 32-25-28-0000-00400-0000:

**The Conditional Use, as presented at the meeting, to allow the expansion of a wastewater treatment facility (public utilities) to be located within an R1 zoning district has been approved with conditions to include the following:**

- 1) The conditional use is reduced from 46 to less than 15 acres.
- 2) The new west course will be designed without a road from College Parkway to Maplewood.
- 3) The City of Gulf Breeze will not ask for approval to place a tower of any kind on this property. They have no plans for a tower of any kind on the Tiger Point property.
- 4) The City of Gulf Breeze can commit to no commercial (i.e. private commercial operation like a gas station) on this property.
- 5) The out of play areas will be heavily landscaped with native trees like pines and live oaks. (They (the City of Gulf Breeze) will work with a representative or representative committee from SRSB on plans for landscaping improvements.)
- 6) The City of Gulf Breeze is absolutely committed to restoring the back 9 on the west course and to rebuilding the front 9 holes on the west as well. (They will need to design these improvements and make a significant commitment of funds to make this happen. Unless they experience another catastrophe like Ivan or an oil spill resulting in a crash of the golf market, we will have this project completed in 2-3 years. They will be happy to discuss plans and take input on the course layout from a representative or representative committee from SRSB.)
- 7) The reconstruction of the west course will probably result in all new or resurfaced cart paths.
- 8) The City of Gulf Breeze will evaluate the installation of lights on the driving range.
- 9) The City of Gulf Breeze will repair / replace existing fencing. (They will work with the HOA relative to plans for new fencing.)
- 10) The City of Gulf Breeze will do a better job maintaining the fence line from College Parkway around the front 9 holes.
- 11) The management group that operates the golf course will be directed to continue their "roundtable" meeting with the various owner groups and to include Santa Rosa Shores in this process.
- 12) The City of Gulf Breeze commits to landscaping projects that shield the treatment facilities from the neighborhood, odor scrubbers and other upgrades as the new facilities are planned. They will consider a pedestrian path if one is desired as we indicated on the draft plans.

- 13) The City of Gulf Breeze commits to addressing ANY odor issues immediately. They were cleaning, repairing, and upgrading a portion of the treatment facility this past year which took about 8 -10 months. They said that we shouldn't smell any odors at this point. If any residents do smell odors, we need to report it IMMEDIATELY so they can diagnose the issue.
- 14) The City of Gulf Breeze does not have any plans to sell off the driving range but they cannot legally commit to not selling it at some point if they have to from a financial stand point. However, they did commit to giving Paul Stagner first right of refusal on the property and would be interested in a potential lease back if they are forced to sell.
- 15) The City of Gulf Breeze has committed \$200,000.00 in funding for SRSB to use for neighborhood improvements. The funds are approved and available.



## RECOMMENDATION

That the Board approve rural transportation priorities for submittal to the West Florida Regional Planning Council (WFRPC).

## BACKGROUND

On June 22, 2015, Ms. Mary Beth Washnock of the WFRPC will present to the Board input on priorities in the rural area of Santa Rosa County. For the past nine years, the WFRPC has been coordinating priorities for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in areas of the counties outside transportation planning organization (TPO) boundaries. **The priorities are those projects local governments would like to see in the FDOT Five Year Work Program.** County Engineering, Public Works and Planning staff met on May 18<sup>th</sup> to discuss the referenced list of projects. The Town of Jay was solicited and provided input as well. Recommendations for priorities are on the next page.

**Santa Rosa County Rural Priorities  
for FY 2017 – 2021 FDOT Work Program**

**Highway/Roadway Capacity or Safety Improvements**

1. Four-lane SR 87 from the TPO Boundary to the Alabama State Line to promote regional connectivity between the Gulf Coast and I-65. Until SR 87 can be four-laned, passing lanes south of SR 4 to CR 399 would improve safety, where line-of-sight issues create a challenge for fast-moving vehicles and slow-moving farm vehicles to share the road.
2. Add paved shoulders on Munson Highway from SR 87 (Stewart Street) to SR 4 (Hwy 4).
3. Add paved shoulders on CR 197 (Chumuckla Highway) from SR 10 (US 90) to Fox Pond Trail.
4. Install a southbound right turn lane on Alabama St. (Hwy. 89) to Escambia Ave.
5. Install a southbound left turn lane on Alabama St. (Hwy. 89) to Pine Street.

**Sidewalks/Trails**

The pan-tilt-zoom (PTZ) camera in Courtroom 213 at the Santa Rosa County Courthouse is not currently focusing and the PTZ cameras in Courtrooms 101 and 300 are also experiencing issues. Securadyne Systems indicated these cameras which were installed in 2009 are now obsolete and most likely not repairable due to age, but at a minimum, cost \$550 to repair if repairable. Enclosed are two quotes to replace the PTZ cameras in three courtrooms (one to replace all three at the same time and one representing the cost of each camera installation separately).

Also enclosed is a proposed annual service and maintenance agreement from Securadyne Systems should you wish to consider this. This particular package includes repair/replacement of materials and labor, among other options. I recommend the rental fee for the Benny Russell Event Room (575 s.f. – capacity 38) be a flat fee of \$60 for up to 4 hours plus a refundable security cleaning/repair deposit of \$50. The event room ancillary equipment includes tables, chairs, refrigerator, ice machine, sink, and prep area. The room will provide a dry and cool/warm area for reserved events. I would also recommend reserving the large pavilion (40' x 20') so citizens can be assured they have a secured pavilion for their event; pavilion rental is \$35 plus tax. The park will have 6 – 12' x 12' pavilions remaining that will be open to the public at no charge on a first come-first serve basis; as well as the large pavilion when it is not reserved. I recommend we limit the hours for each venue to 4 hours per user to allow more citizens the ability to utilize the facilities. This recommendation is being proposed due to the number of request we receive on a monthly basis for the citizens to reserve these areas. The recommended rental fees are in-line with other county facility rental fees and substantially lower than local venues that provides activities such as our adjacent extensive playground. Triple Play in Cantonment provides 90 minutes of indoor play on inflatables for a group of 25 at the cost of \$195, the cost to rent a room at the Guy Thompson Community Center in Milton is \$55 for 4 hours with no guarantee of ancillary equipment and no included-adjacent play areas, and the Sanders Beach-Corinne Jones Small Meeting Room (capacity 20) rents for \$50 per hour with a 3 hour minimum.

Increase in regular maintenance and weekend overtime hours will be required for rentable areas.






The Units will utilize non-ad valorem assessments to insure that all property owners benefiting from the street lighting shall fund the complete cost of such services.

Santa Rosa County is authorized by Chapters 125 & 197, Florida Statutes, to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

3. It is the purpose of this Ordinance to implement the provisions of Chapter 125 and 197, Florida Statutes, and the covenants contained in any ordinance, resolution, or indenture securing the issuance of financing for the projects. This Ordinance is adopted under the authority and power granted the Board under Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, and Section 197.3631, Florida Statutes and other applicable laws.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.**

For the purpose of this Ordinance, the definitions contained in this section shall apply unless otherwise specifically stated. When not inconsistent with the context words used in the present tense include the future tense, words in the plural number include the singular, and words in the singular number include the plural. Words used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the meaning given to them in the Act.

1. "ANNUAL STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT" means the annual assessment imposed upon a parcel of real property for the provision of street lighting services.
2. "ANNUAL STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT ROLL" means the list prepared by the County and confirmed by the Board containing a summary description of each parcel of real property within the unit, the name and address of the Owner of each such parcel as indicated on the records maintained by the Property Appraiser and the assessment authorized by this Ordinance against each parcel.
3. "BOARD" means the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County, Florida, or the governing body by any other name in which the general legislative powers of the County are vested.
4. "CLERK" means the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Santa Rosa County, Florida.
5. "COUNTY" means Santa Rosa County, Florida.
6. "GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY" any local, state, or federal agency.
7. "OWNER" means the person or persons owning an interest in real property located within the unit.
8. "PERSON" means an individual, partnership, corporation, joint venture, private or public service company or entity, however organized.
9. "PROPERTY APPRAISER" means the Property Appraiser of Santa Rosa County, Florida.
10. "RATE RESOLUTION" means the resolution adopted under the provisions of Section 6 of this Ordinance incorporating a schedule of annual assessments to be imposed upon the Owners of all Real Property in the Unit.
11. "REAL PROPERTY" means all real property located in the unit.
12. "TAX COLLECTOR" means the Tax Collector of Santa Rosa County, Florida.

13. "UNIT" means the Autumn Trace Boulevard Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit), The Forest at Oriole Beach Subdivision Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit), Oak Leigh Place Subdivision Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit), and Summerset Estates II Subdivision Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit).

**SECTION 3. CREATION OF UNIT.**

Pursuant to Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, there is hereby established the Autumn Trace Boulevard Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit), The Forest at Oriole Beach Subdivision Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit), Oak Leigh Place Subdivision Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit), and Summerset Estates II Subdivision Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit). The boundaries of the Units shall consist of the properties depicted in the attached maps.

**SECTION 4. PURPOSE.**

It is the purpose of this Ordinance to establish a schedule of assessments to fund street lighting and to provide for a method and procedure for the collection of such established assessments.

**SECTION 5. DETERMINATION OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS AND CHARGES; PUBLIC HEARING.**

A. It is hereby declared that the provision of funding for street lighting is a benefit and improvement to all real property in the Unit regardless of use and occupancy of such property.

B. There is hereby imposed on the Assessment Date against each parcel in the Units and Assessment for the provision of street lighting services.

C. The amount of the Assessment imposed each Fiscal Year against each parcel shall be at the rate established in the Rate Resolution adopted pursuant to this ordinance.

**SECTION 6. ADOPTION OF RATE RESOLUTION AND ANNUAL STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT ROLL.**

A. The Rate Resolution shall fix and establish the Assessment to be imposed in each parcel category.

B. The Board shall adopt by resolution a tentative Rate Resolution establishing the Assessments proposed to be imposed against each parcel in the Units for the purpose of

providing street lighting. Upon adoption by the Board of the tentative Rate Resolution, the County Administrator shall cause to be prepared a preliminary Annual Assessment Roll.

C. Upon the preparation of the preliminary Annual Assessment Roll, the Board shall hold a public hearing to adopt the Rate Resolution and the Annual Assessment Roll for the ensuing Fiscal Year. Notice of the proposed assessments shall be mailed to owners as required by Florida Statutes specifying the amount of the proposed assessment and the time and location of the public hearing. At such public hearing, the Board shall hear comments and objections from Owners and other members of the public as to the proposed Assessments. The Board shall also hear comments or objections from any Owner or member of the public as to the method of apportionment of the cost of funding the street lighting against any parcel within the unit. The Board shall make such increase, decrease or revision to any proposed Assessment, as it shall deem necessary or appropriate and shall adopt a Rate Resolution. In addition, the Board shall make such changes, modifications, or additions as necessary to conform the preliminary Annual Assessment Roll with the adopted Rate Resolution and this Ordinance. The Board may continue said public hearing to a date and time certain without the necessity of further public notice to allow prior to final adoption increases, decreases, or revisions to the tentative Rate Resolution or for such other reason deemed necessary in the sole discretion of the Board. Upon completion of such public hearing the Board may approve the final rate resolution.

D. Notwithstanding the mailing or publication of a proposed schedule of assessments, the Board shall have full and absolute discretion at such public hearing to increase, decrease, or revise any proposed Street Lighting Assessment.

**SECTION 7. UTILIZATION OF STATUTORY COLLECTION PROCEDURES.**

A. The Collection of the Assessments shall be in the manner provided for the uniform collection of non-ad valorem assessment and in accordance with the provisions of Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes (Supp.)(1988), or its successor in function.

B. The collection of Assessments pursuant to this section shall be subject to all collection procedures of Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, including provisions relating to discount for early payment, prepayment by installment method, deferred payment penalty for delinquent payment, and issuance and sale of tax certificates and tax deeds for nonpayment.

C. The Tax Collector shall include on the Notice of Ad Valorem Tax and Non-Ad Valorem Assessments mailed under Section 197.3635, Florida Statutes (Supp.)(1988), or its

successor in function, the Assessment for each parcel listed on the Real Property Assessment Roll as incorporated on the Annual Assessment Roll.

**SECTION 8.** All street lighting services provided shall be completely funded by the assessments established pursuant to this ordinance.

**SECTION 9. CODIFICATION.**

The provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the code of laws and ordinances of the County of Santa Rosa. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or any other appropriate word.

**SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of any other provision and to that end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

**SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon the filing of a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Department of State within ten (10) days after enactment.



4. "CLERK" means the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Santa Rosa County, Florida.

5. "COUNTY" means Santa Rosa County, Florida.

6. "GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY" any local, state, or federal agency.

7. "OWNER" means the person or persons owning an interest in real property located within the unit.

8. "PERSON" means an individual, partnership, corporation, joint venture, private or public service company or entity, however organized.

Pursuant to Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, there is hereby established the Ponderosa Drive Paving, Water and Sewer Municipal Service Benefit Unit. The boundaries of such Unit shall consist of the properties depicted in the attached map.

**SECTION 4. PURPOSE.**

It is the purpose of this Ordinance to establish a schedule of assessments to fund the paving, water and sewer improvements and to provide for a method and procedure for the collection of such established assessments.

**SECTION 5. DETERMINATION OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS AND CHARGES; PUBLIC HEARING.**

A. It is hereby declared that providing the paving, providing of water service and the construction of the sewage collection system and providing of sewer collection service is a benefit and improvement to all real property in the unit regardless of use and occupancy of such property. The construction, operation, and maintenance of the system directly improves and benefits all real property by ensuring a source for the disposal of sewage being generated, or potentially to be generated, on such real property that is practical and compatible with the health and safety of all citizens in the unit.

B. There is hereby imposed on the Assessment Date against each parcel in the Unit an Assessment for the provision of water service and a sewage collection system as provided under the provisions of this Ordinance.

C. The amount of the Assessment imposed each Fiscal Year against each parcel shall be at the rate established in the Rate Resolution adopted pursuant to this ordinance.

D. It is the intent of the Board that the costs of construction of the water and sewage collection systems shall be amortized over a number of years. The amount of the assessment and number of years to be imposed shall be specified in the rate resolution. Said resolution may be amended or modified as provided by this ordinance and law.

**SECTION 6. ADOPTION OF RATE RESOLUTION AND ANNUAL ASSESSMENT ROLL.**

A. The Rate Resolution shall fix and establish for the specified years:

1. The Assessment to be imposed, and

2. The number of years said assessment will be imposed.

B. On or before August 1 of each year, the Board shall adopt by resolution a tentative Rate Resolution establishing the Assessments proposed to be imposed against each parcel in the Unit for the purpose of providing the design/planning for paving, water and sewage collection systems. Upon adoption by the Board of the tentative Rate Resolution, the County Administrator shall cause to be prepared a preliminary Annual Assessment Roll and upon completion shall file such preliminary roll with the Clerk for public inspection.

C. The Board shall hold a public hearing to adopt the Rate Resolution and the Annual Assessment Roll for the ensuing Fiscal Year. Such hearing shall be held between June 1 and September 15.

At such public hearing, the Board shall hear comments and objections from Owners and other members of the public as to the proposed Assessments and shall review the preliminary Assessment Roll prepared by the County Administrator for preparation in conformity with the tentative Rate Resolution and this Ordinance. The Board shall also hear comments or objections from any Owner or member of the public as to the method of apportionment of the cost of funding the water/sewer services against any parcel within the unit. The Board shall make such increase, decrease or revision to any proposed Assessment, as it shall deem necessary or appropriate and shall adopt a Rate Resolution. In addition, the Board shall make such changes, modifications or additions as necessary to conform the preliminary Annual Assessment Roll with the adopted Rate Resolution and this Ordinance. The Board may continue said public hearing to a date and time certain without the necessity of further public notice to allow prior to final adoption increases, decreases or revisions to the tentative Rate Resolution or changes, modification or additions to the preliminary Assessment Roll or for such other reason deemed necessary in the sole discretion of the Board. If upon completion of such public hearing the Board shall be satisfied that the Annual Assessment Roll has been prepared in conformity with the Rate Resolution and this Ordinance, it shall ratify and confirm such roll and the Chairman of the Board shall certify the roll to the Tax Collector no later than September 15 of each year, unless a subsequent date is approved by the Tax Collector.

D. Notice of the date, time, and place of the public hearing for the adoption of the Rate Resolution and the Assessment Roll shall be as provided in Section 197.3632(4)(b), Florida Statutes (Supp.)(1988).

E. Notwithstanding the mailing or publication of a proposed schedule of assessments, the Board shall have full and absolute discretion at such public hearing to increase, decrease or revise any proposed Assessment.

**SECTION 7. UTILIZATION OF STATUTORY COLLECTION PROCEDURES.**

A. The Collection of the Assessments shall be in the manner provided for the uniform collection of non-ad valorem assessment and in accordance with the provisions of Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes (Supp.)(1988), or its successor in function.

B. The collection of Assessments pursuant to this section shall be subject to all collection procedures of Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, including provisions relating to discount for early payment, prepayment by installment method, deferred payment penalty for delinquent payment, and issuance and sale of tax certificates and tax deeds for nonpayment.

C. The Tax Collector shall include on the Notice of Ad Valorem Tax and Non-Ad Valorem Assessments mailed under Section 197.3635, Florida Statutes (Supp.)(1988), or its successor in function, the Assessment for each parcel listed on the Real Property Assessment Roll as incorporated on the Annual Assessment Roll.

**SECTION 8. CODIFICATION.**

The provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the code of laws and ordinances of the County of Santa Rosa. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or any other appropriate word.

**SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of any other provision and to that end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

**SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of State within ten (10) days after enactment, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgment from that office that said Ordinance has been filed.



**AN ORDINANCE OF SANTA ROSA COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE LITTLE DUCK CIRCLE PAVING, WATER AND SEWER MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSING OF ASSESSMENTS BY THE COUNTY FOR PAVING, WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SUCH SPECIAL ASSESSMENT BY THE NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT PROCEDURE; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA ROSA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

It is hereby found and declared by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County:

**SECTION 1. FINDINGS.**

1. It is necessary to provide for the financing of the paving, construction of water service and sewage collection system on Little Duck Circle.
2. The Santa Rosa County Board of County Commissioners finds that the most equitable method of providing such funding is through the creation of the Little Duck Circle Paving, Water, and Sewer Municipal Service Benefit Unit (Unit) to include the properties depicted in the attached map.

The Unit will utilize non-ad valorem assessments to insure that all property owners benefiting from the improvements shall fund the complete cost of such service.

Santa Rosa County is authorized by Chapters 125 & 197, Florida Statutes, to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

3. It is the purpose of this Ordinance to implement the provisions of Chapter 125 and 197, Florida Statutes, and the covenants contained in any ordinance, resolution, or indenture securing the issuance of financing for the project. This Ordinance is adopted under the authority and power granted the Board under Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, and Section 197.3631, Florida Statutes and other applicable laws.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.**

For the purpose of this Ordinance, the definitions contained in this section shall apply unless otherwise specifically stated. When not inconsistent with the context words used in the present tense include the future tense, words in the plural number include the singular, and words

in the singular number include the plural. Words used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the meaning given to them in the Act.

1. "ANNUAL PAVING WATER/SEWER ASSESSMENT" means the annual assessment imposed upon a parcel of real property for the provision of paving, water service and sewer collection system. Said assessment shall be assessed for multiple years to amortize the initial cost of constructing the system.

2. "ANNUAL PAVING WATER/SEWER ASSESSMENT ROLL" means the list prepared by the County and confirmed by the Board containing a summary description of each parcel of real property within the unit, the name and address of the Owner of each such parcel as indicated on the records maintained by the Property Appraiser and the assessment authorized by this Ordinance against each parcel.

3. "BOARD" means the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County, Florida, or the governing body by any other name in which the general legislative powers of the County are vested.

4. "CLERK" means the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Santa Rosa County, Florida.

5. "COUNTY" means Santa Rosa County, Florida.

6. "GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY" any local, state, or federal agency.

7. "OWNER" means the person or persons owning an interest in real property located within the unit.

8. "PERSON" means an individual, partnership, corporation, joint venture, private or public service company or entity, however organized.

9. "PROPERTY APPRAISER" means the Property Appraiser of Santa Rosa County, Florida.

10. "RATE RESOLUTION" means the resolution adopted under the provisions of Section 6 of this Ordinance incorporating a schedule of annual assessments to be imposed upon the Owners of all Real Property in the Unit.

11. "REAL PROPERTY" means all real property located in the unit.

12. "WATER/SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM" the "SYSTEM" shall include the water service and sewage collection system.

13. "TAX COLLECTOR" means the Tax Collector of Santa Rosa County, Florida.

14. "UNIT" means Little Duck Circle Paving, Water and Sewer Municipal Service Benefit Unit.

**SECTION 3. CREATION OF UNIT.**

Pursuant to Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, there is hereby established the Little Duck Circle Paving, Water and Sewer Municipal Service Benefit Unit. The boundaries of such Unit shall consist of the properties depicted in the attached map.

**SECTION 4. PURPOSE.**

It is the purpose of this Ordinance to establish a schedule of assessments to fund the paving, water service and sewer improvements and to provide for a method and procedure for the collection of such established assessments.

**SECTION 5. DETERMINATION OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS AND CHARGES; PUBLIC HEARING.**

A. It is hereby declared that providing the paving, providing of water service and providing for the construction of the sewage collection system is a benefit and improvement to all real property in the unit regardless of use and occupancy of such property. The construction, operation, and maintenance of the system directly improves and benefits all real property by ensuring a source for the disposal of sewage being generated, or potentially to be generated, on such real property that is practical and compatible with the health and safety of all citizens in the unit.

B. There is hereby imposed on the Assessment Date against each parcel in the Unit an Assessment for the provision of paving, water service and a sewage collection system as provided under the provisions of this Ordinance.

C. The amount of the Assessment imposed each Fiscal Year against each parcel shall be at the rate established in the Rate Resolution adopted pursuant to this ordinance.

D. It is the intent of the Board that the costs of paving and construction of the water and sewage collection systems shall be amortized over a number of years. The amount of the assessment and number of years to be imposed shall be specified in the rate resolution. Said resolution may be amended or modified as provided by this ordinance and law.

**SECTION 6. ADOPTION OF RATE RESOLUTION AND ANNUAL ASSESSMENT ROLL.**

A. The Rate Resolution shall fix and establish for the specified years:

1. The Assessment to be imposed, and
2. The number of years said assessment will be imposed.

B. On or before August 1 of each year, the Board shall adopt by resolution a tentative Rate Resolution establishing the Assessments proposed to be imposed against each parcel in the Unit for the purpose of providing the design/planning for paving, water and sewage collection systems. Upon adoption by the Board of the tentative Rate Resolution, the County Administrator shall cause to be prepared a preliminary Annual Assessment Roll and upon completion shall file such preliminary roll with the Clerk for public inspection.

C. The Board shall hold a public hearing to adopt the Rate Resolution and the Annual Assessment Roll for the ensuing Fiscal Year. Such hearing shall be held between June 1 and September 15.

At such public hearing, the Board shall hear comments and objections from Owners and other members of the public as to the proposed Assessments and shall review the preliminary Assessment Roll prepared by the County Administrator for preparation in conformity with the tentative Rate Resolution and this Ordinance. The Board shall also hear comments or objections from any Owner or member of the public as to the method of apportionment of the cost of funding the water/sewer services against any parcel within the unit. The Board shall make such increase, decrease or revision to any proposed Assessment, as it shall deem necessary or appropriate and shall adopt a Rate Resolution. In addition, the Board shall make such changes, modifications or additions as necessary to conform the preliminary Annual Assessment Roll with the adopted Rate Resolution and this Ordinance. The Board may continue said public hearing to a date and time certain without the necessity of further public notice to allow prior to final adoption increases, decreases or revisions to the tentative Rate Resolution or changes, modification or additions to the preliminary Assessment Roll or for such other reason deemed necessary in the sole discretion of the Board. 



Hunter, the Road and Bridge Dept., solicited bids/proposal options for either the purchase or lease of wheeled excavator machines. We are seeking to acquire two new machines to replace our two most troublesome machines. Through our procurement process, we received two qualifying proposals that addressed both the purchase of the machines as well as leasing options. Based on our review of the proposals, we recommend that the County pursue entering into a 48 month lease agreement with Cowin Equipment Co., Inc. for two Volvo EW180E machines. We feel the warranty offered on the Cowin machines better meets our needs. We support the 48 month lease over the 36 month lease because the cost to purchase an extended warranty for the fourth year (if we choose to purchase the machines) would exceed the cost saving of the 36 month lease option. At the end of the lease period, we will have the option to purchase the machines, or to pursue other options, as we see fit.

The proposals do include an offer to purchase for our two old machines. While the proposal from Cowin offers less money, we feel the superior warranty from Cowin outweighs the difference.

Hello Henry,

As per our conversation, here are all of the final invoices for CSA Ocean Sciences. I have also attached a new letter of request for payment. Please discard all of the previous email attachments, as these will replace them. This completes our presently contracted work with CSA, for consultation and development of a mitigation plan, as required by the FDEP. I have also attached the CSA consultant agreement, and the CSA agreement addendum.

Please pay the attached CSA invoices which total \$26,304.22: #10826 for \$13,422.00; #18027 for \$8,567.35; #18176 for \$5,777.17, and subtract credit memo #18178 for \$-1,462.30, from our MSBU fund, at your earliest convenience.

As far as future expenditures go, we will at some point have a final invoice from Wetland Sciences, our main consultant. I expect it to be less than \$10,000. The next major expenditure will be after we get our FDEP permit approved, and get a concurring permit from the Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE). At that point we will need to begin transplanting the Seagrass (the required permit mitigation). This will require us to re-hire CSA to do the work. Since we are closing in on the middle of Seagrass growing season, it is not likely that any transplantation will occur in 2015, but will be postponed until next Spring when the Seagrass begins to grow again. There is, however, a chance that it could occur this year before the weather turns colder. Since we are still in the process of finalizing our permit, and I don't have an exact figure of the amount of transplanting that will need to take place, so I don't have an estimate of cost for that activity yet.

The next expense, and hopefully the last, will be the actual dredging of the sand out of the channels, after the Seagrass has been removed and transplanted. Again, at this time I don't have an estimate of the cubic yards of sand that will be removed, which will determine the dredging costs. Once we get our permit approved by the FDEP and the ACOE, we will have all of those numbers, and in all likelihood, these activities will not occur until Spring 2016.

Navarre High School's NJROTC Raider Battalion continues to strive for excellence in our school and our community. They were recognized again this year as a "Distinguished Unit with Academic Honors" for the 12<sup>th</sup> consecutive year. They were selected as **#1 in all of Area 8** again this year. This was the 4<sup>th</sup> time in the last 7 years that they have reached the #1 mark. Our cadets continue to support our community by contributing over 9,200 hours of their own time thus far at the Navarre Beach Clean-Ups, Senior Citizens Center clean up, Memorial Day Ceremony and Parade, Caring and Sharing at Thanksgiving and Christmas, Thursday Nights in Navarre, assisted several schools' Open Houses, Science Discovery Nights and Family Culture Night. They also raised over \$8,000 for Relay for Life. They have distinguished themselves this year again in the "September 11" Memorial Ceremony as well as "Pearl Harbor" Commemorative Service placing over 3,000 American flags in ground and then standing watch over them for a 24-hour period.

All of our staff officers of the Navarre High NJROTC Unit have been trained and inspired by the training afforded them at Leadership Academy and Basic Leadership Training camps conducted in the summer months. We had five of our cadets selected this year for 4 year ROTC Scholarships, with two receiving US Naval Academy Appointments. All of these cadets were graduates of these fine leadership schools.

In the past, you as elected leaders of our community have recognized that this valuable asset of our youth (soon to be adults) is worth our community's support. Your continued support is requested on behalf of these future leaders in the form of providing funding once again for these camps. This summer we plan to send 36 cadets to both camps at a cost of \$4415. Our cadets were given an extra opportunity to attend another Summer Leadership School, hosted by the Pensacola High School Air Force JROTC unit to be held at Hurlburt and we have 10 cadets attending that camp also, at a cost of \$60.00 each. Additionally, our week-long summer orientation camp for incoming freshman cadets held at Navarre High School each year has a tuition cost of \$70.00 and we have over 83 newbies signed up for that camp this week. We have never refused to accept anyone for lack of funds and the numbers usually runs in the range of 5 to 10 cadets. If your budget would allow you to spend the same \$2500 as last year or more, for these summer leadership/orientation camps, it would be a great investment into the development of our young citizens. Your contribution and support for these worthwhile endeavors will help reinforce to them, that their hard work does not go unnoticed and would be greatly appreciated.
