**LOW COST EQUINE GELDING CLINIC
SATURDAY, MARCH 10, 2012**

In an effort to reduce the number of unwanted horses in Northwest Florida, SRCHAC and the Unwanted Horse Coalition will be sponsoring a low-cost gelding clinic at 8685 Highway 90, Milton, FL 32583.

Participating veterinarians include:

The cost to the owner will be as follows:

A \$55 donation to the Santa Rosa Horse Assistance Council

- Clinic is open to all qualified applicants to horse owners and horses that reside in Escambia County, Santa Rosa County or Okaloosa County, Florida.
- The horse **MUST** have a current negative Coggins in order to participate (OR the Coggins can be done at the time of surgery for a reduced cost to the owner of \$15.00).
- Tetanus vaccinations done at the time of surgery are included – additional vaccinations can be done for an additional cost.
- Transportation expenses are the responsibility of the horse owner. If help is needed for transportation, please note on your application at the time of registration

- Appointments will ONLY be made following SRCHAC receipt of all paperwork and the \$55 donation – the completed registration paperwork and check should be mailed to SRCHAC, PO Box 775, Bagdad, FL 32530. Payments can also be made via PayPal on the SRCHAC website
- Appointments for qualified horses will be made on a first come, first serve basis following the receipt of all paperwork.
- We must have a minimum of 10 horses to hold the clinic –
- Please read the attached paperwork carefully and fill out completely – if you have any questions, please contact those listed above.
- All stallions must be in good health and both testicles must be descended. The veterinarian reserves the right to refuse to perform the procedure.
