

Request for Qualifications For Engineering Services

Notice is hereby given that the Santa Rosa County Board of County Commissioners is calling for and requesting qualifications for engineering services to perform consulting engineering for the Santa Rosa County Environmental Division.

It is expected that the consultant's contract will consist of fixed hourly costs for all positions required to complete any landfill projects for professional engineering services including but not limited to Class I cell design and regulatory permitting, airspace determination and associated fill timelines, Class III airspace design and regulatory permitting, construction design and permitting, landfill gas collection system design and preparation of engineering plans, specifications, permitting and cost estimates. Services of the consultant shall be under the general direction of the County Environmental Manger, who shall act as the County's representative during the performance of the scope of services.

All proposals shall be considered in accordance with the Florida Competitive Consultant Negotiations Act.

All proposals must be in writing and delivered by hand, Fed Ex, or mail to the Santa Rosa County Procurement Department, 6495 Caroline Street, Suite G, Milton, Florida 32570, and must be received by 10:00 a.m., December 6, 2005. The proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time.

Only proposals received by the aforesated time and date will be considered. Proposals received after the time set for the opening will be rejected and returned unopened to the submitter. All proposals shall be sealed and clearly labeled, "**RFQ- Engineering Services.**" Please provide twelve (12) copies of the proposal.
