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MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS
INDUSTRIAL FOUR-WHEEL DRIVE TRACTOR

GENERAL:

It is the intent of these specifications to describe an Industrial Four-Wheel Drive Tractor in sufficient detail to secure bids on comparable equipment. All parts not specifically mentioned, which are necessary to provide a complete Tractor, shall be included in the bid and shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship to what is usually provided to the trade in general. The machine shall be a new, currently advertised, heavy-duty standard production unit with all standard equipment.

Any units not conforming to these specifications may be rejected, and it will be the responsibility of the manufacturer to conform with the requirements unless deviations have been specifically cited by the bidder and acceptance made on the basis of the exception. Bidder is required to meet or exceed each and every item listed below. Exceptions to specifications may be accepted at the sole discretion of Santa Rosa County.
