WHEREAS, thousands of dedicated telecommunicators daily serve the citizens of the United States by answering their calls for police, fire and emergency medical services and by dispatching the appropriate assistance as quickly as possible; and

WHEREAS, professional telecommunicators are critical to our county's emergency response and homeland security services, dispatching law enforcement, firefighters, emergency medical services, and other emergency responders 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

WHEREAS, professional telecommunicators are not visible as the men and women who arrive on the scene of emergencies, but provide the vital link to public safety services as part of the first responder team; and

WHEREAS, professional telecommunicators exhibit compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job throughout the year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Rosa County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim the week of April 10 – 16, 2011 as

in Santa Rosa County in honor and recognition of our telecommunicators and the vital contributions they make to the safety and well being of our citizens.
