

# PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, Thomas Brent “Boo” Weekley a life-long Santa Rosa Countian, began his golf career in his backyard at Tanglewood Golf and Country Club at the age of thirteen (13) and developed his game as a member of the Milton High School Golf Team; and

**WHEREAS**, Boo Weekley initially qualified as a Professional Golf Association (PGA) tour professional in 2002, and ultimately gained considerable success on the Nationwide Tour, leading that Tour in Top 10 Finishes; driving distance; ball striking accuracy; lowest scoring average, and highest percentage of greens hit in regulation; and finished the 2006 season seventh on the Nationwide Tour money earned list; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 16, 2007, Boo Weekley scored his first PGA Tour victory by winning the 2007 Verizon Heritage in Hilton Head Island in dramatic fashion in what has been described by golf writers as “one of the most riveting and dramatic finishes in PGA history”; and

**WHEREAS**, Boo gained wide acclaim by his tough-minded, clutch finish at Hilton Head, he had already become a fan favorite by thanking tournament volunteers, autographing golf balls and memorabilia for young fans, and responding enthusiastically to gallery support; and

**WHEREAS**, Boo Weekley continues to conduct and comport himself with humility, dignity, and grace reflecting most positively on his parents Tom and Patsy Weekley, his family and friends, and his home County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Santa Rosa County Board of Commissioners in recognition of the outstanding achievements of Thomas Brent “Boo” Weekley does hereby declare April 16th in perpetuity
