## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, David Moore, a Santa Rosa County native and Navarre High School graduate, was deployed to Iraq in March, 2007 where he served proudly as a member of the U.S. Army Second Battalion, 69<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division stationed in Fort Benning, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday June 10, 2007, Specialist Moore suffered a traumatic brain injury when a suicide bomber attacked the convoy in which he was riding killing three American servicemen in an area south of Baghdad known as the "triangle of death" for its frequent al-Qaida and Sunni insurgent attacks and is recovering from his injuries at the military hospital on Fort Bragg, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Moore, the son of Navarre resident Penny Jones, is one of four siblings, including a brother and two sisters, currently serving in the U.S. Army.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Rosa County Board of Commissioners, in recognition of the outstanding bravery and sacrifices made to protect the freedom and rights of all Americans by David Moore, his brother and sisters, and all the men and women who have served and continue to serve in the defense of our nation, do therefore declare Saturday, July 7, 2007,
