# Emergency Unemployment

## **For Employers:**

If you must layoff employees due to extensive damage or interruption of business due to a natural disaster, your employees may be eligible to collect unemployment benefits through the federal program known as, Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA).

## **For Job Seekers:**

Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA) is for workers who have lost their jobs or cannot work, directly due to a natural disaster, but are not eligible for standard unemployment benefits. After a natural disaster, individuals may file for DUA at their local One-Stop Center or any one of the emergency FEMA sites setup in the surrounding areas.

# Temporary Disaster Relief Employment

## **For Employers:**

Local, state, governmental and nonprofit agencies affected by a natural disaster may request temporary workers, at no charge, to assist with clean-up activities and/or humanitarian efforts related to the disaster. Clean-up efforts include demolition, repair, renovation and reconstruction of damaged and destroyed public and nonprofit structures.

## **For Job Seekers:**

Following a natural disaster, a temporary employment program, funded by a National Emergency Grant (NEG), may be available to provide assistance to individuals who have lost their jobs (temporarily or permanently). Affected workers may be assigned to temporary jobs in the community to provide them with employment, and to help the region rebuild after a natural disaster. In addition to temporary job assignments and work experience, participants may also receive job counseling, support services, job search/job development assistance, and referrals to other beneficial services within Workforce Escarosa and the community.
