Be prepared to redial numerous times</li> <li>4. Continue to redial until you either speak to a staff member or you reach the Agency's answering machine</li> </ol> <p>Things to Remember</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Agencies will screen calls to verify eligibility</li> <li>2. Most agencies serve only once per year or per lifetime</li> <li>3. In Escambia County, First Call For Help has up-to-date information on funding availability at agencies, so call 595-5905 for Escambia County information.</li> </ol>
