Requirements:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Excellent Customer Service Skills
- Basic Computer Skills
- Honorable Discharge From U.S. Military (DD214 Required)
- Must Pass Background Check
- Must Be A Dislocated Worker **OR** Meet Income Requirements (see back page)

Occupational Tasks/Activities:

- Administer topical/oral ophthalmic medications
- Assist patients inserting or removing contact lenses
- Call patients to inquire about post-operative status or recovery
- Clean or sterilize ophthalmic or surgical instruments
- Conduct ocular motility tests to measure function of eye muscles
- Maintain ophthalmic instruments or equipment
- Document pupil size and look for abnormalities
- Take and document patients' medical histories
- Measure and record lens power, using lensometers
- Measure visual acuity, including near, distance, pinhole, or dynamic visual acuity using appropriate tests
- Operate ophthalmic equipment, such as retinoscopes
- Instruct patients on how to use drops, vitamins or visual monitoring devices
