Have a passion for butterflies? If so, you may want to consider becoming a docent for the Panhandle Butterfly House located in Navarre Park. Volunteers are needed to conduct tours of the butterfly sanctuary, help with special events, and if you enjoy kids, work with the Education Coordinators on youth programs. No experience is required.

Training for Panhandle Butterfly House Docents begins with an orientation given by Theresa Friday, Extension Faculty, UF/IFAS Santa Rosa County Extension. The class will include information on the butterfly life cycle, native butterflies, butterfly gardening and the docent program.
