

COUNTY ATTORNEY –SANTA ROSA COUNTY, FLORIDA

Applications are being accepted for the position of Santa Rosa County Attorney. This position is appointed by the Santa Rosa County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) (County Seat – Milton) and is a contract position. The County Attorney provides legal counsel to the BCC, County Administration, County Departments, and to various boards and committees created by the BCC. The County Attorney’s Office consists of the County Attorney and legal assistant.

Requirements include a Juris Doctorate from an accredited law school, membership in the Florida Bar for a minimum period of seven years, and qualifications to practice in Federal and Appellate courts. Experience in areas of local government law and litigation experience in a community comparable to Santa Rosa County is highly desirable.

Santa Rosa County is a citizen friendly organization. Successful candidate must have the ability and desire to communicate with and assist citizens who make inquiries regarding County processes.

The successful candidate must have office-management, budget, and leadership experience and be a forthright and effective communicator, able to distinguish between legal advice and policy-setting.
