NOTE:

The above information is being requested, in part, to fulfill reporting requirements set by the State of Florida under Florida Administrative Code 62-701.500(4)(a), Solid Waste Management Facilities. The county is required to report all types of waste received in tons and by county of origin. The information will also allow the county to provide commercial haulers information on landfill operations, closures, safety issues and a more efficient means to correct issues dealing with billing, fees and landfill operations.

Failure to provide accurate information may result in delays in processing of incoming loads, correction of errors in billing and the inability of the hauler to receive important information related to landfill operation and fees in a timely manner. In addition, providing inaccurate or false information that results in underpayment of fees for disposal or recycling services may result in rejection of future waste loads. The county may request additional documentation to confirm the type and origin of each load of waste presented for disposal or recycling.

There is NO fee for commercial registration, however, all commercial customers must provide the information listed above to setup charge or pre-paid accounts and utilize disposal and recycling facilities at the Santa Rosa County Central Landfill.

Deadline for providing the information is December 31, 20170
