

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
CONSTRUCTION OF RAILROAD CROSSING

The Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County, Florida will receive sealed bids from qualified licensed Contractors for the removal and replacement of the existing track crossing on Industrial Blvd. within the County Industrial Park in East Milton. Work includes roadway saw-cutting, asphalt removal and replacement (min 3" asphalt thickness per FDOT), compaction, asphalt and base testing, removal and replacement of railroad cross-ties, maintenance of traffic (MOT), ballast material, permitting through CSX, and coordination with track user, as described in the project manuals. Prior to construction contractor shall submit a MOT for review and approval.

All bids must be original and delivered by hand, Fed Ex, or mail to the Office of the Santa Rosa County Procurement Department, 6495 Caroline Street, Suite G, Milton, Florida, 32570; and must be received by 10:00 a.m., March 20, 2007, at which time bids will be opened and read aloud. All interested parties are invited to attend. All bids shall be sealed and clearly labeled "**Bid Railroad Crossing.**" Only bids received by the afore stated time and date will be considered. Bids received after the time set for the bid opening will be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder.

Project documents, including drawings and specifications relative thereto may be inspected at the Santa Rosa County Procurement Department, 6495 Caroline Street, Milton, Florida; and the Santa Rosa County Engineering Department, 6051 Old Bagdad Highway, Suite 300, Milton, Florida.
