MEMORANDUM

Subject: Re-roofing of Santa Rosa County Building

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Minimum Specifications

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Tear-off existing roof system, wall flashings, and roof related sheet metal down to existing structural deck. All debris to be properly disposed of.
2. Directly over existing structural deck, install one layer of Georgia Pacific Densdeck primed secured in a Factory Mutual 1-90 fastening pattern with manufacturer's approved fasteners and 3" plates.
3. Install new 60 mil reinforced PVC roof membrane manufactured by Sika Sarnafil Inc. in a mechanically fastened application method. Install 2 ea perimeter sheets with a maximum width of 24" fastened 6" o.c. with XP fasteners and plates. Field sheets to have a maximum width of 60" fastened 6" o.c. with XP fasteners and plates in membrane laps.
4. Cover all perimeter walls with Sika Sarnafil 60 mil G459 asphalt resistant membrane adhered with 2170 adhesive.
5. Install PVC coated 26 gauge metal along building eave.
6. On top of perimeter walls install 3/8" diameter "J" bolts set in minimum 6" thick concrete fill with minimum embedment of 3" to secure new treated 2X wood nailers.
7. Shop fabricate and install new prepainted .040 aluminum metal coping with a Kynar 500 paint finish. Exterior face of the coping to be secured with a continuous concealed cleat shop fabricated from a .050 mill finished aluminum. Face of cleat to be nailed a minimum of 4" o.c. Interior face of metal coping to be secured with exposed stainless steel fasteners with a neoprene washer at 12" o.c.
8. Upon completion provide owner with Sika Sarnafil 15-year standard warranty.

3. I understand that "convicted" or "conviction" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(b), Florida Statutes, means a finding of guilt or a conviction of a public entity crime, with or without an adjudication of guilt, in any federal or state trial court of record relating to charges brought by indictment or information after July 1, 1989, as a result of a jury verdict, nonjury trial, or entry of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere.

4. I understand that an "affiliate" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(a), Florida Statutes, means:
1. A predecessor or successor of a person convicted of a public entity crime; or
2. An entity under the control of any natural person who is active in the management of the entity and who has been convicted of a public entity crime. The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.

5. I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or appeals to bid on contracts for the provision of goods and services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity. The term "person" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in management of an entity.
