Bids are to be sealed and clearly labeled "**BID – FENCING**". Bids received after the time set for the bid opening will be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder. All interested parties are invited to attend.

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Chain Link Fencing

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MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FENCING

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS:

All fencing is to be of industrial/commercial quality per following specifications. All fencing will be inspected before posts are set in concrete to determine depth and diameter of setting and a final inspection will be made prior to final payment. No payment will be made until all specifications are complied with. The successful bidder is to request the inspection a minimum of 48 hours in advance. If the contractor fails to request and receive an inspection as specified, no payment will be made until the inspection is made and if inspection has not been done prior to the setting of posts, all posts are to be removed and reset with proper inspection.

All fencing is to be K&K and follow the ground contour in such a manner that a standard baseball can not roll under the fence at any point, except where fence goes along asphalted area, install the fence on the asphalt with a 6" clearance from the fabric to the edge of asphalt. This specification may be waived if approved by the Public Works Department.

Chain link fabric to be 9 GA. 2" mesh, 2 oz. G.A.W (Galvanized After Weaving). A manufactures certificate to this fact must be presented before payment.

All gate latches to be of the commercial saddle types. At the Public Works Director's option, a chain and lock with the lock shackle welded to the chain and the chain attached to one side of the fence is to be provided. The lock shall be a Master Brand # 5 (No Substitutes). Locks shall be keyed alike if more than one lock is to be provided per job. All gates to be of commercial quality, welded joint, 1-5/8" O.D. and same fabric as fence, bolted in type.

Post Location - Space line posts equidistant at intervals not exceeding 10 ft (3.05m) in straight line runs. Measure the interval parallel to the grade of the proposed fence and in the line of fence from center to center of the post. Set terminal posts (end, corner, and gate) at the beginning and end of each straight continuous length of fence and at abrupt changes in horizontal alignments.

Bidder shall agree to have all materials and start work within 30 days after being notified by the Public Works Department for each project that has been approved.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to use this bid to set pricing for future fencing needs, however will retain the option to bid out large jobs.

All fencing shall be hung on the exterior of the enclosure.

All contractors shall have the required insurance for working in Santa Rosa County, and on the County right-of-ways.

1. A predecessor or successor of a person convicted of a public entity crime; or
2. An entity under the control of any natural person who is active in the management of the entity and who has been convicted of a public entity crime. The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.

I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or appeals to bid on contracts for the provision of goods and services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity. The term "person" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in management of an entity.
