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MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS CARPET

SCOPE OF WORK:

This Request is for Complete Installation of Carpet Tile and Standard 4” Cove Base around the Interior Walls.

Library Personnel will be responsible for removing all books from the shelving prior to Carpet Tile installation.

Library Personnel will be responsible for removing all shelving prior to and replacing shelving after Carpet Tile Installation.

The successful bidder will also be responsible for removing all existing, glued down carpet, removing it from the job site and preparing the surface for the installation of the new carpet tile to meet the manufacturer's recommend installation.

It will be the responsibility of the successful bidder to schedule the removal and installation of the carpet tile and cove base to coincide with the closing of the Library. The library will be closed June 9, 2009 through June 14, 2009. During this Time the Contractor will need to remove the existing Carpet, and install the New Carpet Tile and Cove Base, It will be necessary to coordinate this action with the Building Maintenance Director or his designated representative.

The color of the carpet will be selected by County Personnel after the Bid is awarded to the successful bidder.

It is the Responsible of the Bidder to Measure the Area to be installed with Carpet Tile and Cove Base.

Bidders may submit a sample of the product with Manufacturer's Specifications for Comparison Purposes.

An additional two (2) cases of Matching Carpet Tile are to be provided after the Installation is complete for future replacement and repairs.

Warranty:

A statement of warranty is required with this bid. The following information must be supplied:

- Copy of Manufacturer's Standard Warranty Policy.
- Copy of any additional manufacturer or dealers warranty policy.
- Name and location of responsible party for processing warranty claims.
- Name and location of responsible party for actual warranty repairs.
- Normal response time to effect repair or replacement after submission of warranty claim.
- The successful bidder shall provide a three (3) year warranty on the workmanship effective after completion of project.

1. A predecessor or successor of a person convicted of a public entity crime; or
2. An entity under the control of any natural person who is active in the management of the entity and who has been convicted of a public entity crime. The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.

I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or appeals to bid on contracts for the provision of goods and services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity. The term "person" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in management of an entity.
