MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Landfill Trash Compactor

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Minimum Specifications Landfill Trash Compactor

1. General:

The specifications are intended to describe a steel-wheeled trash compactor for all season use on materials commonly disposed in Class I and Class III Landfills. The machine must be constructed of all new components, be unused and be the latest production model of the manufacturer and EPA Tier 3 compliant. The minimum operating weight must be at least 80,000 pounds.

2. Engine & Power Train:

Minimum 380 H.P. diesel engine, water-cooled, replaceable element dry type air cleaner with electronically controlled power shift transmission and torque converter with a minimum of 2 forward and 2 reverse speeds. Heavy-duty axles, drivelines, universal joints, and wheel ends. All wheel drive system.

3. Certified Rebuild Availability for Power Train:

Available certified rebuild program of power train components to include, but not limited to, engine, transmission, torque converter, final drive and axle, electrical switches, sending units, harnesses, and control modules. Must include a manufactures warranty on completion of rebuild.

4. Electrical System:

24-volt system with minimum 65-amp alternator, operational lights minimum 2 front and 2 rear.

5. Gauges And Indicators:

Gauges and indicators shall be provided for all critical system components and safety indicators during operations.

6. Engine/Transmission Protection System:

Engine/Transmission protection system designed to warn and shut down engine when engine lube oil pressure is low, engine coolant level is low and/or engine coolant temperature is high, transmission temperature is high or transmission pressure is low.

7. Blade:

Blade shall be equipped with trash screen capable of spreading refuse and cover dirt 14' minimum width 6' minimum height, semi-u design, reversible and replaceable cutting edges.

8. Compaction wheels:

Compaction wheels shall be constructed of steel with staggered chopper cleats welded to the outside drum surface to provide maximum crushing and traction. Inner and outer wheel surfaces and cleats shall be hard surfaced and abrasion resistant for maximum wear life.

9. Operational Items:

Air-conditioned and heated cab with sound suppression, Rollover Protective Structure/Falling Object Protective Structure (ROPS/FOPS) system, rear view mirrors; best available seat offered by manufacturer, horn, cab light, and fire extinguisher

10. Shielding, Guards And Service Points:

Sensitive components and equipment shall be designed, to the greatest extent possible, with protective shields, guards or doors to prevent damage from debris, dirt and foreign objects. Routine service points such as radiator and air conditioning screens, air filters and grease fittings shall be easily accessible for regular inspection and servicing.

11. Miscellaneous:

Two copies of operator's manual, shop manual, parts manual to be supplied. Parts must be available within 75 miles of Milton, Florida. Inventory shall be of sufficient size and variety to offer a 95% availability within 48 hours from time of customer order. Normal maintenance items (filters, belts, hoses, etc.) shall not exceed 24 hours.

 2. An entity under the control of any natural person who is active in the management of the entity and who has been convicted of a public entity crime. The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.

I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or appeals to bid on contracts for the provision of goods and services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity. The term "person" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in management of an entity.
