

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**  
**NAVARRE BEACH WWTF CLARIFIER**  
**REHABILITATION PROJECT**

The Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County, Florida will receive sealed bids from qualified licensed Contractors for the Navarre Bridge WWTF Clarifier Rehabilitation Project. The completed work will provide a new secondary clarifier mechanism, and includes demolition of the equipment and piping associated with the existing 42-foot diameter clarifier, and installing a new clarifier mechanism and piping within the existing concrete structure.

All bids must be original and delivered by hand, Fed Ex, or mail to the Santa Rosa County Procurement Department at 6495 Caroline Street, Milton, Florida, 32570; and must be received by 10:00 A. M., October 2, 2012, at which time bids will be opened and read aloud. All interested parties are invited to attend. Bids are to be sealed and clearly labeled “**NAVARRE BEACH WWTF CLARIFIER REHABILITATION**”. Bids received after the time set for opening will be rejected and returned to the bidder unopened.
