

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS
BEACH RESTORATION PROJECT**

The Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County, Florida will receive sealed bids from qualified licensed contractors for the **NAVARRE BEACH RESTORATION PROJECT**. The contractor shall provide all plants, labor, equipment, supplies and any other materials required to perform and complete all operations in connection with excavating, transporting, placing and grading (with tilling if required) of approximately 1,600,000 cubic yards of sand fill with native dune vegetation on Santa Rosa County beaches as specified in the plans and project manual. Construction shall be performed by use of a hydraulic pipeline dredge (directly to shore or using one or more scows/barges) or a hopper dredge, a mechanical (clamshell) dredge will not be allowed.

All bids must be original and delivered by hand, Fed Ex, or mail to the Santa Rosa County Procurement Office, 6495 Caroline Street Suite G, Milton, Florida, 32570; and must be received by 10:00 a.m., December 1, 2015, at which time bids will be opened and read aloud. All interested parties are invited to attend. Bids are to be sealed and clearly labeled “**BID – NAVARRE BEACH RESTORATION PROJECT**”. Bids received after the time set for the bid opening will be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder.
