

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS  
DERELICT VESSEL REMOVAL**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County, Florida is soliciting proposals for the removal and disposal of two vessels determined to be derelict. Vessel one is located in Gulf Breeze, east of the Shoreline Park boat ramp, LAT 30 deg 21', LONG 87 deg 9'. Vessel two (Symphonia) is located east of the Navarre Beach Bridge, LAT 30 deg 24', LONG 86 deg, 50'. Only properly licensed and insured contractors are invited to submit proposals. All work must be done in accordance with FDEP, COE and FWC requirements. Proof of insurance coverage under the U. S. Longshoremen & Harbor Workers and Jones Act will be required to be turned in with the proposal.

All proposals must be in writing and shall include a salvage plan. FDEP concurrence with this plan shall be the responsibility of the successful submitters. Each vessel shall be addressed as a separate proposal, and will be awarded as such. Proposals may be delivered by hand or Fed Ex to the Santa Rosa County Procurement Department, 6495 Caroline Street, Suite G, Milton, Florida, 32570; and must be received by 10:00 a.m., April 27, 2010. All proposals shall be sealed and clearly labeled either, "**RFP- REMOVAL VESSEL ONE or TWO**". Please provide one (1) original and eleven (11) copies of the proposal. Proposals will be publicly opened at this time. Only proposals received by the fore stated time and date will be considered. Proposals received after the time set for opening will be rejected and returned to the submitter.
