



## RESTORE Act Projects Dirt Road Paving in Districts 1, 4, & 5

### Project Description

This project includes the paving of approximately 4.30 miles of dirt roads in Santa Rosa County Districts 1, 4, and 5. Included roads in this program are primarily located on the Fairpoint Peninsula and were strategically identified for paving as a means of stabilizing soil, controlling erosion, and minimizing sediment runoff into Escambia Bay, Santa Rosa Sound, and East Bay which has a detrimental effect on water quality, marine life, and sea grasses.

The roads will be paved to normal county paving standards. Site preparation, compaction, final grading and dressing of road shoulders will be completed by Santa Rosa County with no costs charged to the grant.
