# Rattlesnake Bluff Road Sedimentation Reduction

### Project Description

This project includes road stabilization of Rattlesnake Bluff Road at the Wolf Creek crossing site. This activity contributes to a larger effort by the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill Florida Trustee Implementation Group (FLTIG) to eliminate erosion where Wolf Creek, a tributary of the Yellow River, is crossed by unpaved Rattlesnake Bluff Road on Eglin Air Force Base.

The project was identified in the *2010 Inventory and Prioritization of Impaired Sites in the Yellow River Watershed in Alabama and Florida Report* by the Nature Conservancy and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Wolf Creek is the highest priority crossing site not yet restored in the Santa Rosa County section of the Yellow River.
