As of June 12, 2020

The half-cent local option sales tax was passed by approximately two-thirds of Santa Rosa County voters on August 30, 2016 and went into effect January 1, 2017.

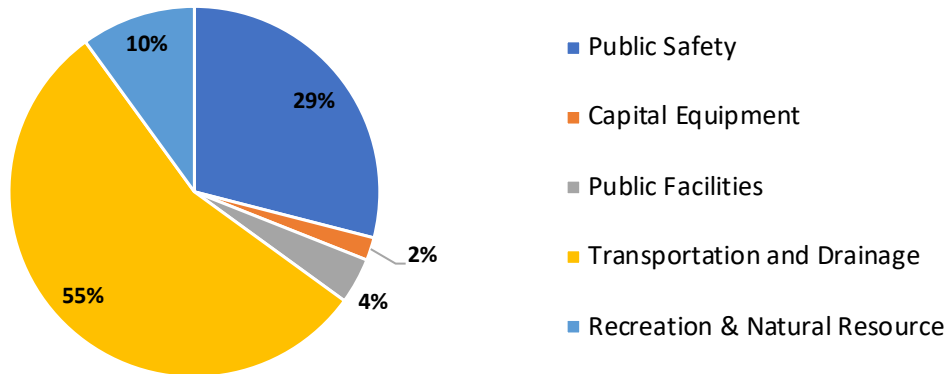
Authorized Uses
