Official Street Suffixes

Only the below Street Suffixes are acceptable for new streets in Santa Rosa County effective 02/2004.

Suffix Name	Abbreviation	Definition
Alley	ALY	A narrow street or passageway between or behind city buildings.
Avenue	AV	A broad roadway lined with trees.
Boulevard	BLVD	A street divided by a landscaped center or median, often flanked by sidewalks.
Causeway	CSWY	A raised roadway, as across water or marshland
Circle	CIR	A street that intersects another street only once and terminates in a closed loop or a semicircular road that begins and circles back to terminate on the same road
Court	CT	An uninterrupted short street that dead ends or dead ends at a cul-de-sac
Drive	DR	A curvilinear street of which continues to the other right of way
Highway	HWY	A designated state or federal highway, usually designed to allow a large portion of relatively high-speed traffic between cities
Lane	LN	A narrow way or passage between walls, hedges, or fences
Parkway	PKWY	A broad landscaped highway, often divided by a planted median strip
Road	RD	An open, general public way for the passage of vehicles
Street	ST	A public way or thoroughfare in a city or town, usually with a sidewalk or sidewalks
Trail	TR	A rough path in wild country. A public way following any curvilinear street
Way	WAY	A widely applied thoroughfare designation usually utilized in residential areas
