The Santa Rosa Sheriff's Office would like to apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for FY 2016 in the amount of \$15,595.00 for the SRSO Mass Casualty Response Program.

The Santa Rosa Sheriff's Office is seeking approval from the board to utilize the grant funds acquired for this Mass Casualty Response Program in order to equip more of our deputies in the Patrol Division and School Resource Division with enhanced live saving capabilities. All grant money will be used to purchase Mass Casualty Rapid Response Kits that include 10 Trauma Kits and 10 Tourniquets each along with training in Active Shooter/Mass Casualty situations.

Santa Rosa Sheriff's Office will utilize these kits and training for the Patrol Division to allow for expanded coverage of Santa Rosa County along with the School Resource Division to protect our children in schools. By having these kits available to SRO's and deputies on patrol, the response time will become faster and more efficient for those trying to save lives.
