Can you please forward this request for use of the grass area and parking lot area to the Board of County Commission. This request also provides the route and schedule for all 3 days of The Warrior Ride "Tour de Sunshine" on Saturday February 24-27, 2016.

Early Registration for The Warrior Ride Community Riders at 0700 hours. Setup by The Warrior Ride Staff would start between 0600 and 0615 hours.

The Warrior Ride, is a 501c3 Non-Profit Organization Founded by Bob Racine 8 years ago, The Warrior Ride was introduced to Combat Injured Service Members to help them rehabilitate through adaptive cycling, The unique format and Bob's motto "We Ride as Fast as the Slowest Rider" has given 1000's of Combat Injured Service Members the confidence and willingness to complete a 3 day 100-mile bike ride.

As the Florida Event Coordinator for The Warrior Ride "Tour de Sunshine" please accept the following requests for this 3 day event:

- Request permission to use the grassy area between Willing St and Elmira St between the Blackwater Bistro and the Veterans Memorial Plaza
- Request permission to use the gravel parking area between Willing St and Elmira St between the Blackwater Bistro and the Veterans Memorial Plaza

Schedule for the 3 day adaptive riding event will be as follows: (please note that Combat Injured Service Member Arrival to Hotel, Event Check-in and Bike Fitting will be on Wednesday February 24, 2016.

The Host Hotel for the event will be: Milton Inn and Suites Hwy 87 S Milton, Florida 32570.

Please Note: Road Closures will not be necessary for this event. Stopping on Hwy 90, Avalon Blvd, Hwy 98 and Hwy 87 South will be for emergency only.

Day 1 Veteran Ride - Thursday February 25, 2016. Leave hotel at 0830 hours. (2) Santa Rosa County Sheriff Escorts, TWR Support Vehicles plus 35 Combat Injured Service Members on Adaptive HandCycles, Recumbent Cycles and Upright Bicycles.

- Arrive at Milton Veteran Memorial Plaza before 0930 hours
- Opening Ceremony Starts at 0930 hours
- After ceremony is over:
- Ride to W.H. Rhodes Elementary (school visit)
- Arrive at Milton Fire Department for Lunch
- Ride Blackwater Heritage State Trail
- Ride to Pace Fire Department (End of Day 1)
- Distance: Approximately 36 miles

Day 2 Veteran Ride - Friday February 26, 2016. Leave hotel at 0745 hours. (2) Santa Rosa County Sheriff Escorts, TWR Support Vehicles plus 35 Combat Injured Service Members on Adaptive HandCycles, Recumbent Cycles and Upright Bicycles.

- Day 2 Start Point will be at Lou Sobh's Milton Chevrolet
- Ride will begin at 0830 hours
- Ride to Benny Russell Elementary School (school visit)
- Ride to Avalon Middle School (school visit)
- Proceed on Avalon Blvd towards Garcon Bridge Toll Plaza
- Proceed to Garcon Bridge
- At Avalon Blvd and Hwy 98 (Turn Left)
- Proceed to Abercrombie Road
- Abercrombie Road to Bay Blvd (Turn Right)
- Proceed on Bay Blvd to Hwy 87
- Turn Left on Hwy 87
- Proceed to Coastline Calvary Chapel (End of Day 2)
- Distance: Approximately 30 miles

Day 3 Community Rider Day - Saturday February 27, 2016. This is the day that the Community Riders are invited to register (\$35.00) and ride with the Combat Injured Service Members and Non Service Connected Veterans. The Start/Stop point for todays ride is projected to be at the Blackwater Bistro in Downtown Milton. Note: there will not be an escort by the Santa Rosa Sheriffs Department. There will be approximately 1-2 miles of escort by The Warrior Ride Founder, Bob Racine.

- Mile 13 Woodville Road, Ventura Road, Cobb Road

- Mile 14-15 Garcon Point Road
- Mile 16 Caroline Street
- Mile 17-21 Dogwood
- Mile 22-25 Stewart Street
- Mile 26-32 Caroline Street
- Complete ride at Blackwater Bistro 5147 Elmira Street Downtown Milton
- Ride Blackwater Heritage State Trail
- Distance: Approximately 32 miles
