Bids received after the time set for the bid opening will be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder. All interested parties are invited to attend.

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Loader / Backhoe

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Minimum Specifications Loader / Backhoe

1. General:

The specifications are intended to describe a Rubber tire loader/backhoe. The machine must be new, unused, and the latest production model of the manufacturer. The unit must have a minimum operating weight of 13,000 pounds.

2. Engine & Power Train:

A diesel engine, with no less than 70 net horse power, minimally equipped as follows: dry type air filters with restriction indicator.

3. Electrical System:

Standard electrical system with heavy duty alternator (minimum 65 amp) and heavy duty battery or batteries.

4. Gauges, Warning Lights and Alarms:

Tachometer/hour meter, engine water temperature, converter oil temperature, fuel, volt meter, engine oil temperature, and backup alarm coolant temperature.

5. Safety Switches:

Automatic safety devices shall be installed to stop the engine without damage in case of oil pressure failure or engine overheating.

6. Transmission:

A synchronized four speed with torque converter with transmission oil cooler.

7. Drive:

All-Wheel Drive.

8. Brakes:

Inboard, wet-multiple disk, self-adjusting, self equalizing, and hydraulically actuated. Sealed from water, mud and dust contamination. Parking brake shall be independent of service brake.

9. Steering:

Shall have hydrostatic power steering with emergency manual mode.

10. Cab:

ROPS/FOPS canopy with self-cleaning steps. The seat shall be suspension vinyl swivel, with armrests and seat belts. Vandal protection shall cover the instrument panel. At least one rearview mirror.

11. Loader:

The loader shall have hydraulic self-leveling and a bucket-level indicator. Lift capacity to full height, lb 5,700.

12. Backhoe:

Shall be equipped with an extendible dipperstick. The swing arc shall be no less than 180 degrees. Shall be equipped with wing stabilizers with dirt pads.

13. Special Equipment:

Work lights front and rear. Back up alarm. Vandalism protection. The equipment with all related components and attachments shall conform to all state and Federal safety standards and requirements.

14. Delivery Time:

Delivery time should be stated, but is expected within six weeks of order.

15. WARRANTY:

Manufacturers standard warranty should be clearly stated. Responsibility for transportation of the machine or in-field service during warranty periods shall be the responsibility of the bidder. In addition to the manufacturer's standard warranty, bidder is asked to submit a bid for a minimum of 4 additional years, warranty of the power train. Items included in power train warranty, should be clearly stated. If during warranty period the machine cannot be repaired to full operating status within 72 hours a replacement machine shall be provided by the bidder at no cost to the county.

16. REPAIR PARTS AND SERVICE:

Since the continuous operation of the Loader/Backhoe is the utmost importance and sometimes of an emergency nature, it is necessary that the successful bidder be in position to render prompt parts and service. The successful bidder shall maintain and/or have access to parts inventory within 75 miles of Milton, Florida. Said parts inventory shall be of sufficient size and variety to offer a level of parts availability of 95% within 48 hours from time of order by customer. Availability of normal maintenance items such as filters, vee belts, hydraulic lines and hoses shall not exceed 24 hours. Bidder shall attach his proposed program for parts and service availability for evaluation. Review of the bidder's ability to provide prompt parts and service will be used in determining low, qualified bidder.

17. MANUALS:

Successful bidder shall provide two copies of Operator's Manual and two copies of current parts and repair manuals.

The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.
