All interested parties are invited to attend.

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MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS HYDRAULIC EXCAVATOR

General:

It is the intent of these specifications to describe a Hydraulic Excavator in sufficient detail to secure bids on comparable equipment. All parts not specifically mentioned, which are necessary to provide a complete and operational hydraulic excavator, shall be included in the bid and shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship to what is usually provided to the trade in general. The machine shall be the latest model, new currently advertised, heavy-duty standard production unit with all standard equipment.

Any units not conforming to the intent of these specifications may be rejected, and it will be the responsibility of the manufacturer to conform to the requirements unless any / all exceptions to this bid have been specifically cited by the bidder and acceptance made on the basis of the exception. Bidder is required to meet or exceed each and every item listed below.

Weight:

- Operating weight of excavator shall not be less than 46,000 lbs.

Engine:

- Engine shall be produced by manufacturer, have six cylinders, minimum 389 cubic inch displacement, turbocharged diesel engine that meets all Tier 3 Emissions Standards.
- Engine shall be water cooled, with a minimum net horsepower of 145 at 2000 rpm.
- Machine shall have a 500 hour oil change interval and 5000 hour hydraulic oil change interval.

Hydraulic System:

- Machine shall be equipped with 2 variable displacement piston type pumps.
- Maximum main pump flow of machine will be a minimum of 105 gallons per minute.

Electrical:

- Machine shall have 2, 12 volt batteries.
- Reserve capacity minimum of 400 min.
- Alternator shall be a minimum of 80 amps.

Transmission:

- Dual-path hydrostatic with infinite speed capability.
- Machine shall be capable of speeds of 3.4 mph in forward and reverse.

Tracks and Undercarriage:

- Machine shall have a long undercarriage.
- Machine shall have a minimum of eight (8) rollers on each side.
- Pins and bushings shall be sealed with a minimum of forty-nine (49) single grouser tack shoes.
- Track pads shall be thirty-two (32) inches wide and be equipped with hydraulic track adjusters.
- The excavator shall also have an extended life under carriage.
- Minimum drawbar pull shall not be less than 40,000 lbs.

Operators Station:

- Fully enclosed certified ROPS/FOPS cab with factory air conditioner, heater and defroster.
- Joystick controls on all implements.
- Hand and foot actuated travel controls.
- Shall be equipped with dash mounted gauges and/or monitor system to include:
 - Fuel.
 - Transmission oil temperature.
 - Engine coolant temperature.
 - Engine oil temperature.
 - Voltage.
 - Engine overheat protection with visual and audible alarm.
 - Windshield wiper/washer system.
 - Large side view and rear view mirrors.
 - Swing drift lock.
 - Tool storage.
 - Minimum of two halogen work lights: one mounted on boom and one mounted on frame.
 - Seat shall be high back reclining suspension seat, fully adjustable multi position seat and armrests with minimum 3 inch seat belts.
 - Shall have factory AM/FM radio and speakers.

Arm / Bucket:

- Machine shall be equipped with a minimum of nine foot, six inch (9'6") arm.
- Machine shall have a minimum digging depth of twenty one feet, eight inches (21'8").
- One heavy duty 42-inch, general purpose 1.4 cubic yard bucket with side cutters and D-ring.
- One additional, ditch cleaning bucket with 60-inch 1.25 cubic yard capacity.
- Machine shall be equipped with a HELAC hydraulic joint swivel, installed.

Additional Equipment:

- Machine shall have all standard equipment and shall include: emergency low oil shutdown, heavy duty hinged and lockable engine side shields, reverse warning alarm, vandal protection, mounting steps, hand rails and front pull hooks.

Warranty:

- Manufacturer's standard warranty should be clearly stated. Responsibility for transportation of the machine or in-field service during warranty periods shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder. In addition to the manufacturer's standard warranty, bidder is asked to submit an alternate bid form indicating the price for 4 additional years / 3000 hours of power train warranty. Items included in power train warranty should be clearly identified. If during warranty period the machine cannot be repaired to full operating status within 72 hours a replacement machine shall be provided by the successful bidder at no cost to the county.

Repair Parts & Service:

- Since the continuous operation of the excavator is of the utmost importance and sometimes of an emergency nature, it is necessary that the successful bidder be in position to render prompt parts and service. The successful bidder shall maintain and/or have access to parts inventory within 75 miles of Milton, Florida. Said parts inventory shall be of sufficient size and variety to offer a level of parts availability of 95% within 48 hours from time of order by customer. Availability of normal maintenance items such as filters, vee belts, hydraulic lines and hoses shall not exceed 24 hours. Bidder shall attach their proposed program for parts and service availability for evaluation. Review of the bidder's ability to provide prompt parts and service will be used in determining low, qualified bidder.

Manuals:

- Successful bidder shall provide two copies of Operator's Manual and two copies of current parts and repair manuals.

4. I understand that an "affiliate" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(a), Florida Statutes, means:
 1. A predecessor or successor of a person convicted of a public entity crime; or
 2. An entity under the control of any natural person who is active in the management of the entity and who has been convicted of a public entity crime. The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.

I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or appeals to bid on contracts for the provision of goods and services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity. The term "person" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in management of an entity.
