MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS

Front End Loader with Rubber Tires

1. General:

The specifications are intended to describe a rubber tire front end loader. The machine must be constructed of all new components, be unused and be the latest production model of the manufacturer. Operating weight shall be no less than 38,000 lbs.

2. Engine:

The engine shall meet Tier IV non-road emissions standards. Shall have a minimum of 180 hp @ 2,200 RPM, six cylinders, turbocharged, water cooled engine. Engine shall have access from both sides with side opening. Air cleaner shall be dry type, dual element. Engine shall be manufactures model.

3. Power Train:

It shall have a torque-converter, power shift, countershaft style transmission. Shift modes shall be auto or manual. It shall have a steering column mounted F-N-R and gear-select lever. Sight gauge for transmission shall be at ground level. Front axle with hydraulic locking differential.

4. Electrical System:

The electrical system shall be a 24 volt system with a minimum of 55 amp alternator. It shall have an electrical disconnect switch. It shall be equipped with analog gauges for: engine coolant temperature, transmission oil temperature, fuel level, hydraulic oil temperature, engine oil pressure. Shall have operator warning light for: check engine, engine oil pressure, engine coolant temperature, engine air restriction, battery voltage, transmission filter restriction, brake pressure, hydraulic oil filter, hydraulic oil temperature. Shall have digital readout for: engine RPM, odometer, transmission gear indicator, speedometer, and hour meter. It shall have a reverse warning alarm.

5. Standard Features:

Loader shall be equipped with 23.5 R25 radial tires, with full front and full rear fenders; shall have a built in counterweight with locking pin in drawbar; shall have a vandal protection package that includes a lockable engine enclosure, lockable rear grille and a lockable fuel fill. Fuel tank to be located inside the frame and shall have a minimum of 70 gallons or the ability to run for two days with ground-level fueling. Cooling system shall have a hydraulically driven fan with hinged swing-out grille. Radiator, hydraulic cooler and transmission cooler set side by side for better cooling and easier clean out. Fan shall have a guard around it for safety.

6. Operator Station:

Shall be equipped with cab and air filter with ROPS/FOPS protection and be multi-plane isolation mounted for noise and vibration reduction. Shall have factory installed heat and air conditioning. Seat to be air suspension, cloth covered with armrest. Loader shall have two outside rearview mirrors (right and left side) and one inside rearview mirror. Have a sun visor, tilt steering column, and a spinner knob for steering wheel. Shall have a factory installed AM/FM radio with speakers. It shall come with a fire extinguisher, retractable seat belt and slip resistant steps with hand rails. Shifter to be steering column mounted, twist-grip shift lever.

7. Lights:

Shall be equipped with driving lights with guards, turn signals and flashers, stop and tail lights, also equipped with work lights, two in front and two in rear.

8. Operational Items:

Bucket with replaceable teeth capability and to be a minimum of four cubic yards with Quick Coupler; A grapple fork with quick coupler attachment; A third functions hydraulic valve with single lever control and auxiliary lever for third function.

9. Ride Control

10. Single joy stick function for bucket curl, raise and lower.

11. Two parts manuals and two service manuals.

12. Front and rear wipers.

13. Air ride seat.

14. Ability to receive replacement parts within 48 hours.

15. Bidder shall have the ability to service and repair the equipment after warranty has expired.

The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.

I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or appeals to bid on contracts for the provision of goods and services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity.
