MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS
COMPACT TRACK LOADER

GENERAL:

It is the intent of these specifications to describe a Compact Track Loader in sufficient detail to secure quotes on comparable equipment. All parts not specifically mentioned, which are necessary to provide a complete and operational Compact Track Loader, shall be included in the bid and shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship to what is usually provided to the trade in general. The machine shall be the latest model, new currently advertised, heavy-duty standard production unit with all standard equipment.

Any units not conforming to the intent of these specifications may be rejected.

ENGINE:

1. Interim Tier 4 emissions certified, 4 cylinder turbo-charged diesel engine.
2. Minimum 95 horse net power.

POWERTRAIN / TRANSMISSION:

1. Shall have a fully hydrostatic track drive.
2. Transmission shall have variable tandem hydrostatic piston pumps that drive two fully reversing hydrostatic motors.
3. Minimum 17 inch wide rubber tracks.

CAPACITIES:

1. Fuel capacity, minimum 25 gallons.
2. Oil Capacity, minimum 9 quarts.
3. Coolant capacity, minimum 4 gallons.
4. Hydraulic oil capacity, minimum 9 gallons.

HYDRAULIC SYSTEM:

1. Machine will be equipped with a High Flow Option with Minimum 34gpm @ 3500 psi.
2. Machine will be equipped with a hydraulic oil cooler.
3. Machine shall be equipped with quick connect / disconnect fittings.

PERFORMANCE:

1. Operating weight, minimum 11,500 lbs.
2. Tipping load, minimum 9,000 lbs.
3. 35% of tipping load, not less than 3,200 lbs.
4. 50% of tipping load, not less than 4,700 lbs.
5. Boom breakout force, not less than 6,000 lbs.
6. Bucket breakout force, not less than 13,500 lbs.
7. Height to hinge pin shall not be more than 128 inches.

BRAKES:

1. Wet disc.

SAFETY, CAB, CONTROLS:

1. Fully enclosed sound suppressed cab with roll over protection system and falling object protective system.
2. Factory installed heating and air conditioning with pressurized front and rear windshield washer / wiper.
3. Gauges will display in either light emitting diode (LED) or liquid crystal display (LCD) and shall include at a minimum: maintenance clock, volt meter, hour meter, engine preheat, tachometer, coolant temperature, hydraulic oil temperature, oil pressure, fuel gauge, Diagnostic service codes, seat belt and parking brake indicator.
4. Front and rear working lights, beacon light and back up alarm.
5. Adjustable air suspension seat.
6. All controls of machine will be via joysticks with selectable patterns to accommodate operators, machine will include a foot throttle.

1. ¾ inch laminated polycarbonate front door. (ISO 8084)

CONDITIONS:

1. Unit will be a new, currently advertised model, in addition to equipment specified; unit shall be equipped with all standard equipment as specified by the manufacturer for this model, and shall comply with all EPA emission standards and all motor vehicle safety standards as established by the U.S. Department of Transportation regarding the manufacturer of motor vehicles.

DELIVERY:

1. As delivery time may be a factor in determining the lowest quote, state delivery time.

WARRANTY / REPAIR PARTS AND SERVICE:

1. Since the continuous operation of this equipment is of the utmost importance and sometimes of an emergency nature, it is necessary that the selected company be in a position to render prompt parts and service. The selected company shall be able to provide warranty service and maintain and/or have access to parts inventory within 50 miles of Milton, Florida. Said parts inventory shall be of sufficient size and variety to offer a level of parts availability of 95% within 48 hours from time of order by the customer. Availability of normal maintenance items such as filters, vee belts, hydraulic lines, and hoses shall not exceed 24 hours. Quotes shall include proposed program for parts and service availability, which will be used in determination of lowest proposal.
2. Manufacturer's standard warranty should be clearly stated. Responsibility for transportation of the machine or in-field service during warranty periods shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder. In addition to manufacturer's standard warranty, bidders are asked to submit a bid for an additional four years of warranty of powertrain. Items included in powertrain warranty will be clearly stated. If during the warranty period the machine cannot be repaired to full operating status within 72 hours a replacement machine shall be provided by the bidder at no cost to the county.

4. I understand that an "affiliate" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(a), Florida Statutes, means:
1. A predecessor or successor of a person convicted of a public entity crime; or
2. An entity under the control of any natural person who is active in the management of the entity and who has been convicted of a public entity crime. The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.

I understand that a "person" as defined in Paragraph 287.133(1)(e), Florida Statutes, means any natural person or entity organized under the laws of any state or of the United States with legal power to enter into a binding contract and which bids or appeals to bid on contracts for the provision of goods and services let by a public entity, or which otherwise transacts or applies to transact business with a public entity. The term "person" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in management of an entity.
