Tiger Point Community Center Ribbon Cutting

The Santa Rosa County Commission is hosting a ribbon ceremony for the new Tiger Point Community Center located at 1370 Tiger Park Lane in Gulf Breeze Monday, Dec. 2 at 6 p.m. The public is invited to attend the event which includes refreshments donated by Shane's Rib Shack and music from children of the B.E.T.A. Theatre of Northwest Florida.

In addition to offering the public meeting space, the center is equipped to hold, record, and webcast live streaming video of county public meetings. The first public meeting will be the Santa Rosa County Local RESTORE Council Monday, Dec. 9 at 3 p.m. The project is estimated at \$1.2 million funded by District 5 recreational and county capital funds.

Additional features of the Tiger Point Community Center include:

- More than 10,000 square feet of indoor and outdoor space
- Approximately 5,000 sq. ft. building, with a 3,500 sq. ft. multipurpose space
- 1,300 sq. ft. of shaded outdoor play area
- Food prep area
- Covered drop off area
- Office space for the Tiger Point Sports Association

The community center will be managed by the Santa Rosa County Parks Department and will be available to the public for community and private events such as weddings, family reunions and birthday parties beginning Wednesday, Dec. 11. Rental fees range from \$20 per hour to \$100 for eight hours and a \$100 refundable security deposit is required.
